A NOTE ABOUT GRADE ALIGNMENTS FOR 2019/2020

Our congregation has issued Calls to fill vacancies in the principal, 7th and 8th grade teacher, and a 4th grade teacher positions. Because of the way the numbers work, we plan to split grades 3 and 4 the next school year and combine grades 1 and 2. A classroom with 3rd and 4th grades combined would result in a very full classroom with 28 children. A split classroom results in 15 students in 3rd grade and 13 in 4th grade, which will be more manageable. With grades 1 and 2 combined, there will be 24 students in Mrs. Henzi's classroom. We will continue to look at enrollment figures on a year-by-year basis to determine what will work best for combining classes.

 As is our custom at Trinity, this Christmas we have again decided to not do any gift exchange with students or teachers. The Luehring’s 4-year-old daughter, Tabitha, was diagnosed this summer with a cancerous brain tumor. She has already gone through a surgery to remove as much of the tumor as they could, and now she is battling the cancer with chemotherapy. This project is near and dear to our hearts because nine of our Trinity students attend Pastor Luehring’s church. We thank God every day that none of our Trinity students are battling cancer, and we pray that through our efforts we can help Tabitha and her family as they face the long road to recovery.

Here is what we have planned for the rest of December

1. Bracelet Sales- We will sell gold (color for Children’s cancer) bracelets that say “We Stand Together”, which are available at school, basketball games, and church.
2. Free Throw Fun- At halftime of all games on December 14, we will have a shooting contest like they do at MLHS. As prizes, we will give a Laffy Taffy Stick for a made free throw, a ring pop for a made three, and throw a whip crème pie at Mr. Johnson for a made full court shot☺. Cost would be \$1.00 to shoot. We will donate a portion of canteen sales on this day as well.
3. Tie fleece blankets – we will be making blankets for Tabitha and her brother Ian. We will also include cards made by the Trinity students.
4. Volunteer choir- students will sing at St. John’s Woodville, date: TBA, sometime after the New Year.

WISCONSIN PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM

The application window for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) is February 1, 2019 through April 20, 2019. All applications for the WPCP need to be received within this period of time.

Students eligible for Choice Program vouchers are students entering 4K, 5K, or 1st grade whose families meet financial qualifications set by the state, or students transferring from a public school whose families meet those same qualifications. In addition, students who were enrolled in the Choice Program in the previous year or were on a waiting list are eligible for the program. Students who were home-schooled in the previous year are eligible as well, as long as they meet the financial qualification set by the state.

On Thursday, February 28, Trinity Lutheran School will host an informational meeting for parents at which we will present more detailed information on the Choice Program. School Board members will be present and available to speak with you and help answer any questions you may have.
