Best and Brightest of Brillion: Mrs. Marcia Wendt

On Thursday, October 18 the Brillion Chamber of Commerce held its Frist Annual "Best and Brightest of Brillion" celebration at Cobblestone Creek. Mrs. Marcia Wendt received the "Brillion Teacher of the Year" award for her years of dedicated service to Trinity Lutheran Church and School and to the community of Brillion.

Mrs. Wendt spent her childhood years in Collins, and from the time she was in the 4th Grade, Marci wanted to be a teacher. After graduating from Dr. Martin Luther College, she taught for one year at Trinity Lutheran School in Marinette before moving to Brillion, and then she taught for

two years here at Trinity, Brillion before taking nine years off to raise a family. She has spent 38 years in the teaching ministry, and is now working with her 28th teacher candidate. She also serves as a mentor in the Wisconsin Synod's New Teacher Induction program. She truly loves teaching and it shows in the lives of the children who have sat in her classroom.

That's a lot. But it's what Mrs. Wendt does beyond the classroom that sets her apart. She continues to function as a church organist and handbell choir director, and she has served as Sunday School and Vacation Bible School coordinator as well. Although she announced her retirement this past January, when Trinity faced a shortage of teaching staff, Mrs. Wendt graciously agreed to come out of retirement to teach in our 3rd and 4th Grade classroom...and become the "Brett Favre" of our congregation. We deeply appreciate her dedication and humble service.
