Procedures for School Closings

We wanted to update you on the procedures that we will follow in case of a school closing or delay.

1. An FD broadcast message would be sent out as soon as we are notified
2. A notice would be put on the Fast Direct home page
3. Four of the television stations will have the notice sent to them. Channel 2, 5, 11 & 26.
4. The telephone answering machine would have a message on it with the information for the closing/delay.

In order to receive these Fast Direct messages, you must have your current email address listed on your account along with the correct cell phone number and cell phone provider listed. If these items are not on the account you will not receive the message.
