Dismissal Procedures

The following is Trinity's revised plan if parents need to pick up or drop off their child during the school day. If your child has an appointment in which they need to leave school during the day, here is the new plan to follow:

- 1) Notify the office as soon as possible as to what time your child needs to leave.
- 2) When you arrive in the parking lot, call the office at 920-756-3738 to let us know you are here and ready to pick up.
- 3) The office staff will then dismiss your child to meet you outside by your car. If you prefer to meet them at the door outside, please feel free to do so.

Upon returning your child to school

- 1) Call the office from the parking lot to notify them that you are sending your child back into school. You may walk them to the outside door if you prefer.
- 2) Your child should then come to the office to get checked in and, after checking in, will be sent back to the classroom.

This will allow for less visitors in the building and also a good check in and check out system for your child. If someone other than a parent will be picking up or dropping off your child, please give the office their name and description of the vehicle.
