WEEKLY MESSAGE FROM PASTOR FRICKE

We call it Holy Week—the final week of Jesus' life. About half of John's gospel covers that week, and the events of Good Friday stand front and center. Jesus went to the cross and died. John was there. He vividly recalled, "When he had received the drink, Jesus said, 'It is finished'" (John 19:30).

What does that mean, "It is finished?" What is finished? Christ's mission is finished. He came to earth for sinners like us. He came to make payment for our sins. The payment has now been made in full. Mission accomplished. There is nothing to add, nothing left to do. 
TRINITY STUDENTS STAR IN SHREK JR!
