WEEKLY MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL MAROHN

We live in an amazing age when it comes to technology. Our phones, tablets, TVs and other devices give us 24/7 access to news, entertainment, games, and even people from all over the globe. It is amazing to think how quickly and efficiently we are able to learn and communicate. However, when it comes to time students spend on screens, the data is quite concerning.

Recent studies show that the average screentime for **8-10 year olds** is around **6 hours per day**. For pre-teens, **ages 11-14**, it can be as high as **9 hours per day**. These figures don't include time spent on screens for school work. For **ages 2-5**, experts recommend limiting non-education screen time to about **1 hour per day** on weekdays and possibly a little bit more on weekends. The general guideline for ages 6 and older is **1-2 hours per day**.

In 1 Corinthians 6:12, Paul tells us, "I have the right to do anything...but I will not be mastered by anything." I often wonder if our phones and devices have become masters of our time. What impact does screen time have on our families? Are we spending time face to face with loved ones? Are we spending time as families together in God's Word? Are we getting the necessary amount of sleep? These are great questions for all of us to ponder. May God help us to use technology in an appropriate way and with limits both at home and at school!
