WEEKLY MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL MAROHN

That's not fair!

As a father of five and a teacher for 25 years, one of my least favorite phrases is, "That's not fair!" My own children and students have learned over time that I will rarely give credence to this phrase. I know that sounds harsh, but the reality is this sinful world we live in isn't always fair. Even God himself isn't fair.

2 Corinthians 5:10 tells us, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he did while in the body, whether good or bad." ALL must appear. ALL will be judged. ALL will receive what they deserve, whether good or bad, heaven or hell. All people. Including you. Including me. Gulp...
